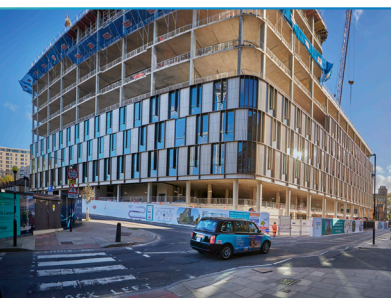

The £300 million centre in Camden will bring eye care, research, and education together under one roof, creating a space where clinicians and scientists can collaborate more easily. The 47,000 m² building will be the new home for Moorfields Eye Hospital NHS Foundation Trust and the UCL Institute of Ophthalmology.

Inside the 10-storey centre's light-filled atrium, gentle curves inspired by nature help create a calm, welcoming space. But while these flowing surfaces are visually striking, they called for plenty of creative problem-solving.

To tackle this and other challenges, we assembled experts from multiple Saint-Gobain businesses, including British Gypsum, Isover, Ecophon, and Weber. Between us, we specified partitions, linings, encasements, and other solutions that sped up installation and improved quality while bringing the impressive design to life.

For instance, Gyproc SoundBloc has been installed to lower noise transmission between spaces, creating a quieter environment which will help people with sight loss communicate more easily. Gyproc DuraLine also offers much-needed durability and impact resistance in a bustling urban space.
